A New Format. Built for the Next Generation

Sensational League is a creator led, digital-native 7v7 women's football league, designed specifically for female athletes and modern fans. Built as a sports entertainment platform, the league combines elite competition, festival-style matchdays, and year-round digital engagement. Our scoring system rewards both sports performance and fan engagement, integrating promotion directly into competition.

A format designed to scale internationally - from the Nordics to UK, and US.

The Draft: Where It All Began

Nearly 200 players registered for the draft. From this pool, our eight captains selected their teams, forming eight squads of 10 players each. With 80 players total from Denmark, Sweden, and England - elite players, academy talents, former internationals, and influencers with a passion for football - the first Sensational League season is ready.

The draft event was hosted at Matchday Productions by Captain and digital powerhouse Cecilie Schmeichel, capturing the decisions, reactions, and early rivalries that now define the league.
